To this end, the committee is dedicated to accomplishing the following activities: Review, plan, and coordinate capital improvements so as to promote a systematic, organized replacement and acquisition schedule; promote the effective coordination and administration of capital spending programs; working with a limited budget, insure the capital needs of the community are met; evaluate and provide the most economical method of financing capital projects; ensure that the financing of planned capital expenditures are consistent with prudent management of the Town's debt schedule and insure wider community participation in the planning and evaluation of capital projects
