Meeting Called to Order: 7:03pm

The Cohasset Board of Sewer Commissioners held a public hearing on Wednesday, April 27, 2022 at 7:00 pm via virtual ZOOM meeting to consider a request from Cook Estate, located on Chittenden Lane. Pam Fahey presented the facts showing the need for Cook Estate to connect to sewer. The Cook Estate development has a failed septic system that has been declared a public health emergency by the Cohasset Board of Public Health. The system cannot be remedied without extreme measures, therefore, they are requesting permission to extend the sewer line at the Deer Hill Pump Station to connect Chittenden Lane to the public sewer system for a permanent solution in response to the public health emergency. The public was invited to offer input on their proposal. This is Article 18 on the warrant for Spring Town Meeting.
